

INTRODUCTION: WHAT IS THE FREERIDE LEARNLINE AND WHAT ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT FACTS YOU NEED TO KNOW?

Information:

The Freeride Learnline from Jakobshorn to Teufi is a freeride route on a yellow-black marked off-piste route. It is passable and secured when open. On the way, the most important information on safety and technique for freeriding is summarised at 8 panels. The panels are marked with a blue sign where you will find the information as a PDF using a QR-code. The individual posts should help you to prepare in future for skiing free terrain, so that you can judge the safety yourself. In this way, the Freeride Learnline offers an unique opportunity to gain initial experience with the dangers and risks as well as self-assessment of off-piste skiing. The Freeride Learnline attempts to facilitate the linking of theoretical avalanche knowledge with practical experience. However, it is in no way a substitute for practice and application under expert guidance.

Rules:

The off-piste route from Jakobshorn to Teufi (No. 14) is marked with coloured posts, but should only be used when secured and open. Safety equipment with avalanche transceiver, probe and shovel should be with you on every off-piste route. For those who are new to off-piste skiing, we recommend booking a mountain guide.
